Since 1991, we have committed to provide assistance to those in need of financial aid, those who struggle to pay for medical treatments, and those affected by disasters. We work closely with hospitals and our reporters at The New Straits Times Press to identify deserving cases and pay their medical treatment fees directly.

MAKING A DIFFERENCE TOGETHER

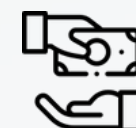
In 2021, the MPNHF, with assistance from government hospitals, medical institutions and welfare departments across Malaysia, worked together to identify cases that deserve support from the fund. This support includes providing necessary aid for those identified to undergo medical treatment and life-saving surgery. A total of RM2,711,678.25 was collected and RM2,080,807.82 was disbursed to cover their medical expenses and other related expenditure throughout the year.

BANTUAN KEMANUSIAAN COVID-19

In light of the on going Covid-19 pandemic, the MPNHF worked closely with medical institutions across Malaysia to aid in the effort to slow down the spread of the virus. Our initiatives includes providing 9 top loading vaccine refrigerators to transport Covid-19 vaccine to remote area across the country. In 2021, a total of RM29,958.45 was collected and RM166,500 was disbursed to succeed our initiative.

In 2021, we provided a total of RM36,009.00 in relief assistance to victims affected by flood, in Selangor, Hulu Langat from a total collection of RM1,520,312.95, including a total of RM207,061.72 carried forward from 2020.

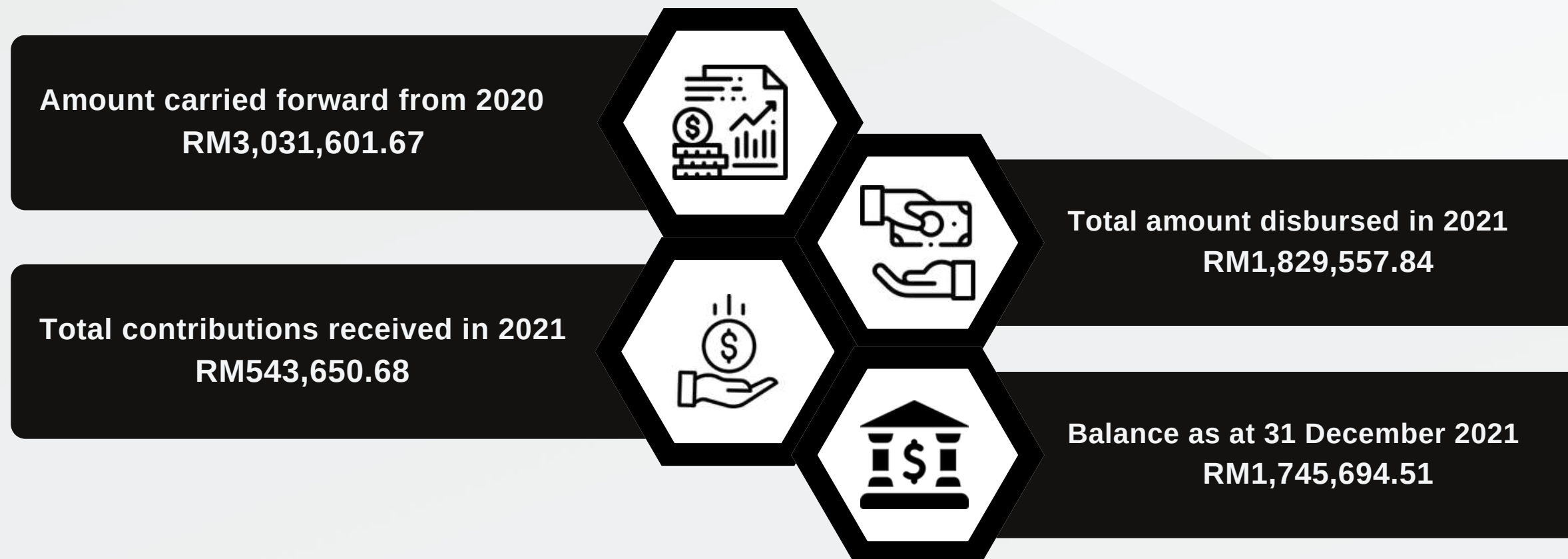

Kuala Pilah: Berat mata memandang berat lagi bahu memikul. Itulah situasi yang dihadapi wartawan sambilan Harian Metro yang menjaga ibu bapanya yang sakit.

Bukan hanya perlu mengurus keperluan harian ayahnya, Yahya Maarof, 75, serta ibunya, Rohah Amin, 72, bahkan Amran, 52 perlu membawa kedua orang tuanya ke klinik kesihatan dan hospital bagi mendapatkan rawatan mengikut jadual ditetapkan.

Malah, Amran juga turut mempunyai temujanji dengan doktor selepas mengidap penyakit berkaitan darah dan pernah dimasukkan ke wad bagi mendapatkan rawatan.

Selain tanggungjawab terhadap ibu bapanya dan diri sendiri, Amran juga perlu memberi perhatian kepada anak bongsunya Fatin Nurshafa Humairah yang kini berusia lima bulan dan turut menerima rawatan susulan sama ada di Hospital Tuanku Ampuan Najihah (HTAN) Kuala Pilah atau Hospital Tuanku Ja'afar (HTJ).

Begitulah rutin Amran, ayahnya perlu dibawa ke hospital dan klinik kesihatan berbeza, sama ada ke Klinik Kesihatan Juasseh, HTAN atau Hospital Serdang selepas menghidap angin ahmar serta kanser prostat.

Ibunya yang mengidap penyakit saraf perlu dibawa untuk rawatan ke Klinik Kesihatan Pertang.

Dia sendiri perlu memenuhi temujanji rawatan sama ada di Klinik Kesihatan Juasseh, HTAN atau HTJ.

Namun tanggungjawab yang digalas tidak pernah dikesalnya bagi memastikan orang tua serta anaknya mendapat perhatian sewajarnya.

Ditemui di rumahnya di Taman Putra, di sini, Amran mengakui dia perlu memberi tumpuan kepada ibu bapanya sehingga tidak begitu aktif sebagai wartawan sambilan.

Rantau: "Sudah tujuh tahun saya tidur atas kerusi roda, rindu rasanya nak tidur atas katil," kata warga emas, Khiri Othman, 65, ketika ditemui di rumahnya di Jalan Besar, di sini, semalam.

Katanya, dia mengalami penyakit angin ahmar sejak 2013 dan sejak itu dia hanya mampu duduk di atas kerusi roda yang kini sangat uzur.

Dia dijaga isteri, Rodzi Kassim, 51, yang setia menemaninya memandangkan mereka tidak dikurniakan anak sejak berkahwin pada 1999.

"Namun, isteri mempunyai seorang anak hasil perkahwinan terdahulu yang kini tinggal di Kuala Lumpur dan sudah berkahwin.

"Kehidupan kami mula berubah selepas terkena serangan angin ahmar, selain pelbagai penyakit termasuk darah tinggi.

"Namun, kejadian saya terjatuh di dalam rumah tiga tahun lalu yang menyebabkan kaki patah memburukkan lagi keadaan," katanya ketika ditemui selepas menerima sumbangan kerusi roda boleh laras daripada Pertubuhan Kebajikan Asnaf Setia Kasih Negeri Sembilan (Perkasih N9), di rumahnya di sini.

Sementara Rodzi berkata, dunia suaminya hanya di atas kerusi roda dan kehidupan mereka hanya bergantung kepada bantuan bulanan daripada Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) RM350, serta Baitulmal berjumlah RM250 untuk membayar sewa rumah sebanyak RM350 sebulan.

Machang: Seorang pemuda rela hidup membujang demi menjaga kedua ibu bapanya yang sudah uzur di Kampung Desa Rebana, di sini.

Mohd Suhairi Junoh, 36, berkata, selepas adik beradiknya berkahwin dan mempunyai keluarga, dia mengambil alih tugas menjaga ibu dan bapanya, Rahmah Salleh, 73, dan Junoh Zakaria, 78, yang memerlukan perhatian disebabkan masalah kesihatan.

Dia berkata, bapanya lumpuh paras pinggang ke bawah selepas terjatuh sejak enam tahun lalu, manakala ibunya pula menderita penyakit saraf, darah tinggi, kencing manis dan sakit lutut selain mata kanan kabur.

"Saya gembira dapat berbakti kepada ibu dan ayah yang selama ini bersusah payah membesarkan saya serta lapan saudara lain, namun seorang daripada kami meninggal dunia pada tahun lalu disebabkan demam denggi.

"Adik beradik yang lain ada kehidupan dan tanggungjawab pada keluarga masing-masing dan saya secara sukarela ingin menggalas tanggungjawab menjaga ibu dan ayah yang sudah tua dan uzur.

"Jika dibandingkan apa yang saya lakukan ini, ia masih tidak mampu membalas pengorbanan mereka yang bersusah payah membesarkan saya selama ini," katanya ketika ditemui di rumahnya di Kampung Desa Rebana, di sini, semalam.

Terdahulu, keluarga ini menerima kunjungan daripada Pemangku Ketua Parti Pribumi Bersatu Malaysia (Bersatu) Bahagian Machang, Kamaruddin Ab Kadir yang menyampaikan bantuan keperluan asas bagi meringankan beban yang ditanggung.

Anak keenam daripada lapan beradik itu berkata, sebelum ini dia bekerja di Kuala Lumpur, namun selepas terbabit dalam kemalangan pada 2013 sehingga menyebabkan tulang belakangnya terpaksa dimasukkan besi, dia mengambil keputusan berhenti kerja dan terus menetap di kampung untuk menjaga ibu bapa.

"Ada ketikanya saya dipanggil bekerja sebagai pemandu lori dengan kadar upah RM100 untuk satu perjalanan setiap kali menghantar barang.

"Upah yang diperoleh itu hanya sekadar cukup makan saja, namun mujurlah ayah mendapat bantuan bulanan daripada Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) sebanyak RM500 yang sedikit sebanyak dapat meringankan beban selain boleh digunakan untuk keperluan perubatannya serta ibu.

6 beranak berhimpit dalam rumah daif hampir roboh [METROTV]

Tempat: Kemiskinan menyebabkan enam sekeluarga berhimpit tinggal dalam sebuah rumah kecil daif tanpa bilik di Kampung Pasir Pekan Hilir di sini, sejak lapan tahun lalu.

Rumah itu dihuni Noor Azuani Rahyu Mohd Said, 32, dan Mohd Hamizi Mohd Hanapiah, 37, bersama empat anak berusia dua hingga 14 tahun.

Menurut Noor Azuani Rahyu, dua lagi anak tirinya yang juga hasil perkahwinan terdahulu Mohd Hamizi berusia 14 dan 16 tahun menumpang di rumah ibu mentuanya di lokasi berhampiran.

Katanya, dua anak tirinya itu akan pulang pada siang sebelum kembali ke rumah nenek mereka.

"Satu ruang dalam rumah ini dijadikan bilik dan ia ditutup dengan papan lapis.

"Ia untuk kegunaan anak, Muhammad Fazreen Ashraff, berusia lapan tahun, Muhammad Sham Rizal, berumur 12 tahun dan Noor Intan Zulaikha Mohd Hasani, berusia 14 tahun," katanya ditemui di kediamannya.

Menurut Noor Azuani Rahyu, anak bongsu, Muhammad Lutfi Muslihudin yang berusia dua tahun tidur di ruang tamu bersama mereka.

Untuk rekod, Muhammad Sham Riza dan Noor Intan Zulaikha adalah anak hasil perkahwinan terdahulu Noor Azuani Rahyu.

Muhammad Lutfi Muslihudin dan Muhammad Fazreen Ashraff pula adalah anak hasil perkahwinannya dengan Mohd Hamizi.

Menurut Noor Azuani Rahyu, dinding serta lantai rumah juga berlubang dan mereka tidak mampu membaikinya.

"Suami bekerja sebagai buruh malah menghidap penyakit angin pasang sejak sekian lama. Ada kalanya dia tidak dapat keluar bekerja. Saya pula hanya mampu membantu dengan membuat kuih dan meletakkannya untuk jualan di kedai kopi berhampiran.

"Kami perlu tanggung ahli keluarga yang ramai dan memang tidak mampu untuk membaiki rumah yang hanya menunggu masa untuk roboh ini," katanya.

Menurut Noor Azuani Rahyu, usahkan baik pulih rumah yang memerlukan kos tinggi malah pintu tandas yang berada di luar rumah

A strict security protocol was placed at the border of Palestine, limiting access to humanitarian initiatives going into the country after a series of missile attacks targeting the Palestinians.

Tabung Kemanusiaan Rohingya Media Prima

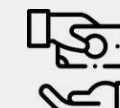
